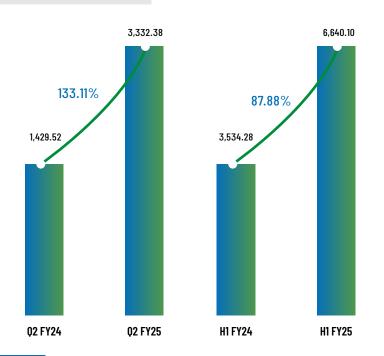

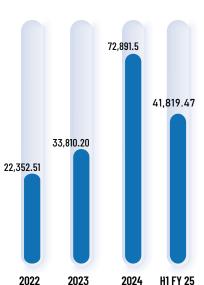

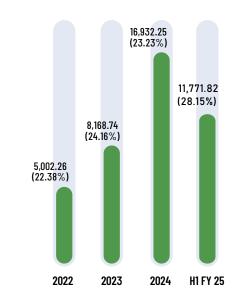

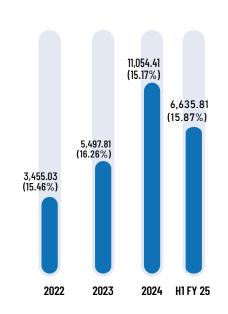




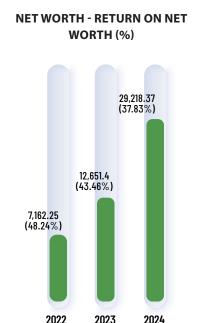
# EBITDA - EBITDA MARGIN AS % OF REVENUE FROM OPERATIONS

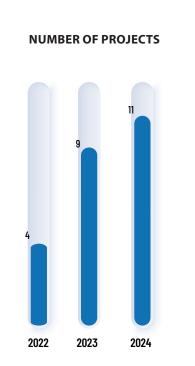


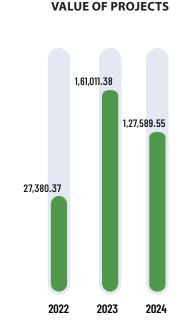
PAT - PAT MARGIN (%)
